Rules and Etiquette

The Great Master Funakoshi, regarded as the founder of modern Karate said "Those who follow Karate-do must consider courtesy of prime importance. Without courtesy Karate-do has no meaning."

- In Dojo always refer to instructors by their proper title (i.e. Senior Instructors Sensei and Assistant Instructor Sempai) all students must formally address all instructors and show respect to instructors and fellow students
- 2. Punctual attendance is expected of all students
- 3. Dojo must be kept clean and in order
- Uniforms must be clean
- 5. All clothing and shoes must be neatly put to the side and collected at the end of class
- No jewellery should be worn during training
- 7. Long hair should be tied up and fingernails should be kept short
- 8. Shoes are not to be worn on the tatami
- 9. No chewing gum is allowed in the training area
- 10. Any students arriving after training has commenced shall wait at the edge of the training area until asked to join class
- 11. Any students leaving the training area before completion of class shall ask permission from class instructor/s
- 12. Bowing (rei) when entering and leaving the tatami
- 13. When training with a partner both shall bow simultaneously before and each section of training
- 14. No one is allowed to enter the dojo while under the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance
- 15. The student must show proper respect to their Sensei and their seniors, being always receptive to criticism. The dojo is a place of personal development and students must have a clear mind and positive attitude, there is no place for negativity or bad attitude
- 16. Behaviour must be respectful, unnecessary roughness, rude language or display of ill temper or disrespect is strictly forbidden
- 17. Harassment or bullying between students will not be tolerated in or outside the dojo and there will be serious consequences for those participating
- 18. No student is to designate themself as an instructor and teach other students
- 19. Do not wear your uniform in public unless participating in a demonstration, en route to the studio or training outdoors
- 20. Students who visit other schools must remember that they will refrain from making any critical comments about any of the styles or instructors of any other martial arts.
